Our Mission

We are a Christ-centered community offering dynamic opportunities for those with Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities alongside their families



WHY

The majority of adults with disabilities sit at home with no purpose and no community - isolated from society and each other

There is a major shortage of government-supported and faith-based programs and services for the I/DD community

Many people with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities receive little to no government assistance for programs and services

There are currently 2,112 individuals with I/DD on the Registry of Unmet Needs in Rockingham (128), Guilford (1328) and Forsyth (656) Counties waiting over 10 years for assistance

WHAT

MJM has been providing a week-long overnight camp experience - Camp Jubilee for up to 48 campers and over 60 volunteers since 2005

MJM offers our His Path Day Program in Forsyth, Guilford and Rockingham Counties, serving over 40 families

MJM offers Touch Point Seminars to encourage and equip families with vital information concerning critical and emerging needs

MJM is expanding our day program to include social enterprise, opening up vocational opportunities for our Heroes

Annual Funding Requirements

Camp Jubilee

\$40,000

MJM's foundational program, Camp Jubilee provides a residential overnight camp for our special friends. Since 2018, MJM has partnered with the Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Educational Center in Rockingham County. Their facility provides our campers with the opportunity to enjoy swimming, canoeing, archery, horseback riding, crafts and much more. As always, campers meet mornings and evenings for worship and live-character Bible stories. One goal each year is to have a one on one camper / staff ratio. Another goal is to make camp affordable through our annual camper scholarship campaign.

Public Awareness & Marketing

\$8,000

With more and more families looking to MJM for programs, information and services, an effective marketing approach is vital to achieving our goal of becoming the "go-to" portal for the special needs community. Creating cutting edge marketing web-based tools and enhanced distributables will help us succeed in this area. Participation in all local area events is equally important for making the Mount Jubilee Ministries' brand more widely known.

Touch Point Seminars (2 per year)

\$2,000

These are live events which address the systemic challenges facing families with I/DD members. MJM hosts large group presentations given by professionals in the service arena, which provide valuable information to help families of those with special needs. Service opportunities are also arranged where families can share experiences and offer one another encouragement and support. Touch Point Seminars provide invaluable networking connections within the special needs community.

Organization Sustainability for 12 months

\$415,000

MJM continues to expand, currently operating three year-around day programs along with camp. With this growth, the need for additional staffing continues in both the program and administrative areas of the ministry. The \$690,000 2023 projected budget reflects more than 80% of the revenue going to programs and services.
